An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Dinamarie McCarthy, an employee of the Department of Children and Families.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 Department of Children and Families shall establish a sick leave bank for Dinamarie McCarthy,  
3 an employee of the Department of Children and Families. Any employee of the Department of  
4 Children and Families may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the  
5 sick leave bank for use by Dinamarie McCarthy. Whenever Dinamarie McCarthy terminates  
6 employment with the Department of Children and Families or requests to dissolve the sick leave  
7 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave  
8 bank.
