An Act designating the official seasoning of the commonwealth .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section (x). “Bell’s Seasoning,” created by William G. Bell, a Boston inventor in 1867
- 3 and manufactured in East Weymouth Massachusetts, shall be the official seasoning of the
- 4 Commonwealth of Massachusetts
