### AN ACT RELATIVE TO CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR RETIREMENT TO NON- WORKING MEMBERS OF THE RESERVE POLICE FORCE IN THE CITY OF MALDEN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, no
- 2 employee of the city of Malden who is a member of the reserve police force shall be granted
- 3 creditable service by the city toward retirement for time served as a member of said force;
- 4 provided, however, that the city of Malden shall grant creditable service toward retirement to an
- 5 employee who is a member of the reserve police force for work actually performed as a member
- 6 of said force.
  
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
