An Act relative to the removal of a trustee of condominium or homeowner associations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11 of Chapter 183A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following subsection :-

3 (o) An elected trustee may be removed before the expiration of his/her term of office, with or

- 4 without cause, by a vote of the unit owners at a meeting duly called where the unit owners
- 5 representing a simple majority percentage interest of more than 50 per cent of those present vote
- 6 in favor of removal. Said unit owners may also vote at said meeting to elect a replacement.
