An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Harwich as the U.S. Navy Lt. Jr. Ralph Wallace Burns Memorial Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The bridge on U.S. highway route 6, spanning state highway route 124 in  
2 the town of Harwich shall be designated and known as the U.S. Navy Lt. Jr. Ralph Wallace  
3 Burns Memorial Bridge, in honor and recognition of U.S Navy Lt. Jr. Ralph Wallace Burns who  
4 lost his life in WW2 while serving as a pilot. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation  
5 shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance with the  
6 standards of the department.

7           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
