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**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**  
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An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Robert A. Montalvo, an employee of the Department of Correction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special, or rule or regulation to the contrary,  
2 the Massachusetts Department of Correction shall establish a sick leave bank for Robert A.  
3 Montalvo, an employee of the department. Any employee of said department may voluntarily  
4 contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for the use by Robert  
5 A. Montalvo. Whenever Robert Montalvo terminates employment with said department or  
6 requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, the balance of the sick leave time shall be transferred to  
7 the Massachusetts Department of Correction paid sick leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not  
8 be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of  
9 the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
