AN ACT REQUIRING TRACKING SUBJECTS IN SCHOOLS..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 71 of The General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended
2 by adding the following sentence:-

3 In all public high schools courses on the bible and international religions shall be taught as required
4 subjects for the purpose of promoting morality and brotherhood.
