AN ACT RELATIVE TO STUDENTS WITH SEVERE DISABILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1I of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 3 Students with severe disabilities who are unable to take the written MCAS assessment and who
- 4 participate in the MCAS alt assessment shall have their MCAS portfolios based on the students individual
- 5 education plan's goals and objectives rather than MCAS standards.
