An Act relative to the installation of nontransparent window materials.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 9D of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after the third paragraph the following paragraph:-
- 3 Any person equipping a motor vehicle with nontransparent windshield and window materials
- 4 shall be licensed as an installer with the registrar. In order to effect this licensing of installers,
- 5 the registrar shall promulgate rules and regulations establishing: (1) the application by and
- 6 examination of installers, (2) the application and examination fees to be paid annually by said
- 7 installers and (3) the suspension and revocation of said licenses. In addition, licensed installers
- 8 shall register with the chief of police in each municipality where installation occurs prior to any
- 9 installation of nontransparent window materials.
