**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court  
(2017-2018)**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Lornece Tull, an employee of the Department of Corrections.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 Department of Corrections (MA Treatment Center – Bridgewater) shall establish a sick leave  
3 bank for Lornece Tull, an employee of the department. Any employee of the department may  
4 voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by  
5 Lornece Tull. Whenever Lornece Tull terminates employment with the department or requests  
6 to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to  
7 the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to  
8 the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined  
9 by the department.

10           2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
