An Act relative to a certain parcel of land in the Charlestown neighborhood of the city of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION X. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the  
2 contrary, a certain parcel of land located at 425 Medford street in the Charlestown section of the  
3 city of Boston shall not be included within the boundaries of any designated port area, except for  
4 the area consisting of approximately 5.47 acres. described as “Maritime Area” on a plan entitled  
5 “Exhibit Plan of Land – Maritime Area,” dated May 29, 2013 prepared by Kelly Engineering  
6 Group, Inc. Said certain parcel of land is located at 425 Medford Street in the Charlestown  
7 section of the City of Boston, assessor's parcel numbers 0201799000 and 0201798000,  
8 containing approximately 839,808sf and 48,965 sf square feet of land and water and is recorded  
9 at Book 621, page179 in the Suffolk county registry of deeds.
