## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act Supporting Municipal Fiscal Stability through a Special Education Stabilization Fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5B of Chapter 40 of the General Laws (2008 Official Edition) shall be amended by
- 2 adding the following paragraph:
- 3 Upon the recommendation of the school committee and the acceptance by majority vote of the
- 4 appropriate legislative body, the school department of any school district shall be authorized to
- 5 retain any unexpended funds of the present fiscal year so voted, to be placed in a separate
- 6 stabilization fund to be utilized in the upcoming fiscal year or years, to pay, without further
- 7 appropriation, for unanticipated and/or unbudgeted costs of special education out of school
- 8 district tuition and/or transportation. The balance in such separate stabilization fund shall not
- 9 exceed 2% of the annual net school spending of the school district.
