#### AN ACT RELATIVE TO FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 127A of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph, the following
- 3 paragraph:-
- 4 The department shall adopt public health regulations that require those establishments
- 5 engaged in the "take out" food service business, which do not have a restroom accessible to the
- 6 general public, to install a sink on their premises for the purpose of hand washing; provided,
- 7 however, that the food service business may install, in the alternative, an acceptable hand
- 8 sanitizer for the use by its patrons and employees.
