An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Laura Sypien, an employee of the Worcester Recovery Center and Hospital.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2   Worcester Recovery Center and Hospital shall establish a sick leave bank for Laura Sypien, an  
3   employee of the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or  
4   more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Laura Sypien. Whenever  
5   Laura Sypien terminates employment with the Worcester Recovery Center and Hospital or  
6   requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be  
7   transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for  
8   absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave  
9   bank as determined by the Worcester Recovery Center and Hospital.
