By Representative Fernandes of Milford and Senator Moore, a joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3937) of John V. Fernandes and Richard T. Moore (by vote of the town) authorizing the town of Hopedale to allow direct deposit of receipts into certain funds. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Twelve
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An Act authorizing the Town of Hopedale to allow direct deposit of receipts into certain funds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The town of Hopedale, acting by and through its board of selectmen, may allow the direct
- 2 deposit, at the discretion of the board, without further appropriation or transfer by town meeting,
- 3 into the Capital Improvement Stabilization Fund, established by town meeting on June 23, 2009,
- 4 of up to 90 per cent of the receipts from the perpetual management and sale of surplus timber
- 5 harvested from the Parklands; and provided, further, that the board of selectmen, in its sole
- 6 discretion, may allow the direct deposit, without further appropriation or transfer by town
- 7 meeting, into a new Parklands Care Stabilization Fund, of up to 10 per cent of the receipts from
- 8 such perpetual management and sale of surplus timber harvested from the Parklands.
