**In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen**

An Act revising the reporting date for the task force on the prevention of unnecessary vacancies following foreclosures.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith an extension of a date for reporting of a task force, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 194 of the acts of 2012 is hereby amended by striking  
2 out the words “December 31, 2013” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- July 21,  
3 2014.

4           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of December 31, 2013.
