AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR JANET RUGGIERI, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE MASSACHUSETTS DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Department of
- 2 Revenue shall establish a sick leave bank for Janet Ruggieri, an employee of the department.
- 3 Any employee of the office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days
- 4 to the sick leave bank for use by Janet Ruggieri. Whenever Janet Ruggieri terminates employment
- 5 with the office or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave
- 6 bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be
- 7 used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the
- 8 sick leave bank as determined by the office.
