AN ACT RELATIVE TO MOTOR VEHICLE POLICE CHASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 268 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following
- 2 section:-
- 3 Section 41. Whoever knowingly operates a motor vehicle on a street, road, alley, or highway in
- 4 this state, to intentionally flee or attempt to elude a law enforcement officer after having received
- 5 a signal from the officer to bring the vehicle to a stop shall be punished by imprisonment in the
- 6 state prison for not less than 2½ years.
