**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act extending the date for issuance of certain licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises in Hanover.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (e) of section 1 of chapter 162 of the acts of 2020 is hereby
2 amended by striking out the words “All licenses granted under this act shall be issued within 3
3 years after the effective date of this act;” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- All
4 licenses granted under this act shall be issued by August 20, 2026;

5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
