AN ACT RELATIVE TO STUDENT TESTING IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1I of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “performance”, in line 14 the following:-,
- 3 provided, however, the total amount of standardized testing per year per grade level shall not
- 4 exceed 6 hours
