## AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF DEPARTMENT HEADS IN THE TOWN OF BROOKLINE .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 270 of the acts of 1985, as amended by section 1 of chapter
- 2 322 of the acts of 1990 and section 1 of chapter 427 of the acts of 1991, is hereby further
- 3 amended by striking out clause (b) and inserting in place thereof the following clause:-
- 4 (b) recruitment and recommendations for appointment by the board of selectmen of all
- 5 department heads, except the librarian, the superintendent of schools, the treasurer-collector, the
- 6 town clerk, and any other department head who is elected or who is appointed by another elected
- 7 board or commission; provided, however, that in the case of the director of recreation, any
- 8 recommendation shall be approved by the park and recreation commission, and in the case of the
- 9 director of the council on aging, any recommendation shall be approved by the council on aging,
- 10 and in making such recommendations, the administrator may in his discretion recommend for

- 11 appointment as department head single candidates whom the board of selectmen shall either
- 12 appoint or reject until one is appointed.
- 13 SECTION 2. Said section 2 of said chapter 270 is hereby further amended by inserting after
- 14 clause (c) the following clause:-
- 15 (c ½) approval of the appointment of all other town employees, except employees of the library,
- 16 employees of the town clerk's office, employees of the school department, and civil service
- 17 employees who are subject to chapter 31 of the General Laws.
