The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act establishing a regional school district planning committee.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by striking Section 14 and inserting in place thereof the following section:

3 Section 14. Any town, by either a majority vote of its selectmen or by vote in town
4 meeting duly called therefore, may create a special unpaid committee to be known as a regional
5 school district planning committee, to consist of three members, including one member of the
6 school committee, to be appointed by the moderator; and may at the same meeting or at a
7 subsequent meeting appropriate for the expense of said committee such sum or sums, not
8 exceeding one tenth of one percent of the assessed valuation of such town in the preceding year,
9 as it may deem necessary. Regional school district planning committee from any two or more
10 towns may join together to form a regional school district planning board or boards. Such
11 regional school district planning board shall organize forthwith upon its formation by the
12 election of a chairman and secretary-treasurer.
