An Act relative to court ordered hospitalizations .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 15 of chapter 123 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended in paragraph (b) by adding at the end of the paragraph the following
- 3 sentence:-
- 4 Unless otherwise ordered by the court making the commitment, any person committed to a
- 5 facility under the provisions of this section shall be restricted in his movements to the buildings
- 6 and grounds of the facility at which he is committed.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 16 of said chapter 123, as so appearing, is hereby amended in paragraph
- 8 (a) by adding at the end of the paragraph the following sentence:-
- 9 Unless otherwise ordered by the court making the commitment, any person committed to a
- 10 facility under the provisions of this paragraph shall be restricted in his movements to the
- 11 buildings and grounds of the facility at which he is committed.

- 12 SECTION 3. Section 18 of said chapter 123, as so appearing, is hereby amended in paragraph
- 13 (a) by adding at the end of the paragraph the following sentence:-
- 14 Unless otherwise ordered by the court making the commitment, any person committed to a
- 15 facility under the provisions of this section shall be restricted in his movements to the buildings
- 16 and grounds of the facility at which he is committed.
