An Act relative to total amounts distributed to cities and town for the purpose of education.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary in each fiscal year  
2 beginning after January 1, 2016 the total amounts to be distributed and paid to each city and  
3 town through chapter 70 education aid shall be at a minimum 17.5 percent of their Foundation  
4 Budget; provided further, that said funds distributed shall be represented in a separate column on  
5 the cherry sheet produced by the department of revenue.
