In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to lottery compliance investigations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 31 of chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "any member or employee of the
- 3 commission", in line 3, the following words:- except as authorized by the director for
- 4 investigative purposes,
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 31 of said chapter 10 is hereby further amended by adding the
- 6 following paragraph:-
- 7 If a winning ticket is sold to any member or employee of the commission who was
- 8 authorized to purchase such ticket for investigative purposes, the proceeds from the winning
- 9 ticket shall be deposited in the General Fund.
