3 SECTION 1. Chapter 40 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2008 official edition, is hereby
4 amended by inserting, after section 22G a new section 22H, “No municipality shall charge a fee
5 and no penalty shall be imposed for the parking of any vehicle owned and driven by a disabled
6 veteran or by a handicapped person and bearing the distinctive number plates authorized by
7 section 2 of chapter 90, or for any vehicle transporting a handicapped person and displaying the
8 special parking identification plate authorized by section 2 of chapter 90, or for any vehicle
9 bearing the official identification of a handicapped person issued by any other state or any
10 Canadian providence parked at a municipally owned parking meter, on street, in a municipal
11 parking lot, or within a municipally owned parking garage.”
