An Act relative to the board of selectmen in the town of Sunderland.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the executive  
2 body of the town of Sunderland, previously known as the board of selectmen, shall be known as  
3 the selectboard, and shall have the powers and authority of a board of selectmen under any  
4 general or special laws.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
