An Act clarifying the application of judicial retirement law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 65D of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “offices”, in line 72, the  
3 following words:- , regardless of whether the service in judicial office or offices was continuous.

4           SECTION 2. Said section 65D of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby further  
5 amended by striking out, in line 104, the word “shall” and inserting in place thereof the  
6 following word:- may.
