**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)**

An Act restoring an increase in the membership of the Board of Health in the city of Framingham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 26 of chapter 111 of the General  
2 Laws, and the repeal of chapter 126 of the acts of 2016 through the adoption of the Framingham  
3 Home Rule Charter, as approved by the voters on April 4, 2017, the Board of Health of the City  
4 of Framingham shall consist of five members, serving staggered terms of three years.

5 SECTION 2. The initial terms of the two new members of the Board of Health of the City  
6 of Framingham added pursuant to section 1 shall be two years and three years, respectively.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
