**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act authorizing the town of Plainville to grant additional licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
2 licensing authority of the town of Plainville may grant 1 additional license for the sale of all
3 alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises pursuant to section 12 of said chapter 138. The
4 licenses shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

5 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
6 licensing authority of the town of Plainville may grant 2 additional licenses for the sale of all
7 alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises pursuant to section 15 of said chapter 138.
8 The licenses shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

9 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
10 licensing authority of the town of Plainville may grant 4 additional licenses for the sale of wines

- 11 and malt beverages not to be drunk on the premises pursuant to said section 15 of said chapter
- 12 138. The licenses shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.
