An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Dawn Parmenter, an employee of the Department of Correction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary,  
2           Department of Correction shall establish a sick leave bank for Dawn Parmenter, an employee of  
3           the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,  
4           personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Dawn Parmenter. Whenever Dawn  
5           Parmenter terminates employment with the Department of Correction or requests to dissolve the  
6           sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended  
7           illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or  
8           disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the  
9           Department of Correction.
