An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Jacqueline Dayton, an employee of the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Office of the Chief  
2   Medical Examiner shall establish a sick leave bank for Jacqueline Dayton, an employee of the  
3   office. Any employee of the office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or  
4   vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Jacqueline Dayton to care for her son. If  
5   Jacqueline Dayton terminates employment with the office or requests to dissolve the sick leave  
6   bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave  
7   bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability  
8   that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the office.
