AN ACT EXEMPTING RICHARD CORCORAN AND KAZIMIERZ R. PIORKOWSKI, JR.  
FROM THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT FOR APPOINTMENT AS A FIREFIGHTER IN THE  
TOWN OF WESTWOOD .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding sections 58, 61A and 61B of chapter 31 of the General Laws, or  
2 any other general or special law to the contrary, Richard Corcoran of the town of Mendon and Kazimierz  
3 R. Piorkowski, Jr. of the town of Millis may have their names certified for original appointment to the  
4 position of firefighter in the town of Westwood, notwithstanding having reached the age of 32 before  
5 taking any civil service examination in connection with such appointment. In all other respects, Richard  
6 Corcoran and Kazimierz R. Piorkowski, Jr. shall be eligible for appointment to the position of firefighter  
7 in the town of Westwood only insofar as they qualify and are selected for employment under chapter 31,  
8 any regulations of the civil service commission and any lawful hiring practices of the town of Westwood.
- 9           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
