An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Susan St. Laurent, an employee of the Office of the Commissioner of Probation.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the office of the commissioner of probation, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule, or regulation to the contrary,  
2 the Office of the Commissioner of Probation shall establish a sick leave bank for Susan St.  
3 Laurent, an employee of the Office of the Commissioner of Probation. Any employee of the  
4 department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave  
5 bank for use by Susan St. Laurent. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated  
6 to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined  
7 by the department. Whenever Susan St. Laurent terminates employment with the department or  
8 requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be  
9 transferred to the extended illness leave bank.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
