In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to municipal parking.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Secretary of Executive office of Housing and Economic Development, in
- 2 consultation with the Commissioner of the Department of Revenue, shall issue a report relative
- 3 to the ways state government agencies can expand the availability of business district parking
- 4 within urban areas and file that report with the Clerks of the House and Senate on or before
- 5 November 30, 2024. This report may review tax incentives, grants, and a special tax status for
- 6 private lot owners with some level of public use or benefit.
