## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act Establishing a Sick Leave Bank for Mr. Clifton Watson, an Employee of the Registry of Motor Vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 registry of motor vehicles shall establish a sick leave bank for Clifton Watson, an employee of  
3 the registry of motor vehicles. Any employee of the registry of motor vehicles may contribute 1  
4 or more sick, personal, or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Clifton Watson. Upon  
5 such time as said Clifton Watson's termination of employment with said department or requests  
6 to dissolve said sick leave bank, the balance of sick leave shall be transferred to the registry of  
7 motor vehicles paid leave bank.

8 Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that  
9 necessitates the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the registry of motor  
10 vehicles.
