Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 431 of the acts of 1998 is hereby amended by striking out the
- 2 words “50 persons” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- 18 persons .
- 3 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
