**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act to harmonize wage laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1A of Chapter 151 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 8, the word “excluded” and inserting
3 in place thereof the following word:- included

4 SECTION 2. Said section 1A of chapter 151, as so appearing, is hereby further amended
5 by inserting after the word “buyer,” in line 31, the following words:- who does not make daily
6 reports or visits to the office or plant of their employer
