### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act ensuring equitable MSBA incentives.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 10 of chapter 70 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-
- 3 (d) Notwithstanding the first sentence of this section, in the case of an approved school
- 4 project where the Base Percentage (A) + Community Income Factor (B1) + Community Property
- 5 Wealth Factor (B2) + Community Poverty Factor (B3) pursuant to this section equal 80 per cent
- 6 or more, the incentive percentage (C) points awarded pursuant to the regulations of the authority
- 7 to the project shall be added to 80 per cent and the reimbursement percentage for the project may
- 8 exceed 80 per cent.
