An Act relative to providing feedback on educator certification tests.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 38G of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2010 Official  
2 Edition, is amended by inserting after the thirteenth paragraph the following paragraph:-

4 “The board shall design a process for any certification tests required in this section that  
5 provides all failing candidates a comprehensive summary of their test results, including areas of  
6 strengths and weaknesses, as well as a list of potential resources the candidate may consult in  
7 attempting to achieve a passing score on their tests. This process shall be annually referred by  
8 the board to the education personnel advisory council established in section 1G of chapter 15 of  
9 the general laws and said council shall annually provide recommendations, if any, on changing  
10 this process in order to better assist candidates failing certification tests.”
