## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Alyssa Nelson, an employee of the Office for Victim Assistance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Office of
- 2 Victim Assistance shall establish a sick leave bank for Alyssa Nelson, an employee of the
- department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal
- 4 or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Alyssa Nelson. If Alyssa Nelson terminates
- 5 employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time
- 6 in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the department paid leave bank. Sick leave bank
- days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the
- 8 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
