### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

An Act to require engine coolant and antifreeze to contain a bittering agent so as to render it unpalatable. .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 94 or the General laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is

- 2 hereby amended by inserting after section 303M the following new section:-
- 3 Section 303N. Notwithstanding any General or special law, or any rule or regulation to the contrary,
- 4 except as may be otherwise provided in this section, engine coolant or antifreeze containing more than 10
- 5 percent ethylene glycol that is manufactured after January 1, 2011 may not be sold in the Commonwealth
- 6 unless said engine coolant and antifreeze shall include denatonium benzoate at a minimum of 30 parts per
- 7 million and a maximum of 50 parts per million as a bittering agent within such product so as to render it
- 8 unpalatable.

- 9 Notwithstanding any General or special law, or any rule or regulation to the contrary, any manufacturer of
- any product for sale in the Commonwealth subject to this section shall maintain a record of the trade
- 11 name, scientific name, and active ingredients of any bittering agent used pursuant to this section, and such
- information shall be available to the public upon request.
- 13 Notwithstanding any General or special law, or any rule or regulation to the contrary, a manufacturer,
- processor, distributor, recycler or seller of an engine coolant or antifreeze that is required to contain an
- aversive agent, as described in the first paragraph of this section, shall not be liable for any personal
- injury or death incurred by any resident of the Commonwealth, or to any property damage, or damage to
- 17 the environment (including natural resources), or economic loss that results from the inclusion of
- denatorium benzoate in any engine coolant or antifreeze, provided that the inclusion of denatorium
- 19 benzoate is present in concentrations described and mandated by paragraph one of this section. The
- 20 limitation on liability, as provided in the first sentence of this paragraph, shall not apply to a particular
- 21 liability to the extent that the cause of such liability is found to be unrelated to the inclusion of
- denatorium benzoate in any engine coolant or antifreeze.

- Notwithstanding any General or special law, or any rule or regulation to the contrary, no city or town, nor
- 24 any subdivision thereof, shall establish nor continue in effect any local ordinance or policy concerning
- any retail containers of engine coolant or antifreeze sold in said city or town, which in any manner shall
- limit or otherwise prohibit the inclusion of a bittering agent in said engine coolant or antifreeze that is in
- 27 any way different from, or in addition to, the provisions of this section.
- 28 The provisions of this section shall not prevent the sale of any motor vehicle in the
- 29 Commonwealth where any engine coolant or antifreeze may be found in the radiator of said
- 30 motor vehicle that does not meet the provisions of paragraph one of this section. The provisions
- 31 of this section shall also not apply to wholesale containers of engine coolant or antifreeze
- 32 containing 55 gallons or more of engine coolant or antifreeze.
- 33 Any person found to have violated the provisions of this section shall be subject to the penalty set forth in
- 34 Section 303M of this chapter for each such violation.
