## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

### AN ACT RELATING TO MCAS TUTORING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Any high School student with at least a 3.0 average in the student's senior year shall, with the
- 2 consent of the school's principal and a recommendation of a teacher, be allowed to commit three
- 3 hours a week to tutoring student in preparation for the MCAS tests, and upon completion of
- 4 tutoring service for one year, be entitled to a tuition credit of \$500.00, if the student matriculates
- 5 to a public state college or university.
- The funds for tuition credit shall come from appropriations for MCAS tutors and shall be
- 7 contingent upon their availability.
