## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act providing that future members of the police force of the town of Sharon shall be exempt from the provisions of the civil service law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 13 of the Acts of 1990 is hereby repealed.
- 2 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the positions of
- 3 the regular and permanent members of the police force of the Town of Sharon shall be exempt
- 4 from the provisions of the civil service law, Chapter 31 of the General Laws; provided, however,
- 5 that the civil service status of any member of said police force who is subject to the provisions of
- 6 said Chapter 31 on the effective date of this act shall not be impaired by this act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
