### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to compulsory full-day kindergarten.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1B of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 117-120, inclusive, the twenty-first
- 3 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:
- 4 The board shall establish the permissible and mandatory ages for school attendance
- 5 provided that each child be required to attend a full-day educational program at kindergarten age.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 1 of chapter 76 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 7 amended by inserting after the word "education", in line 2, the following words:
- 8 "and any child enrolled in full-day kindergarten"
