### AN ACT RELATIVE TO CLASSROOM MATERIALS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 70 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (e) the following subsection: -  
3   (f) additional funds may be allotted if a districts' books and other classroom materials reported  
4   per paragraph (i) of section one of chapter sixty-nine are found to be inadequate. These  
5   additional funds may be awarded for the purchasing of new materials which have been found  
6   effective by use in other districts.
