By Ms. Wolf of Cambridge, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Alice K. Wolf for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Timothy J. O'Brien, an employee of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services. Public Service.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act establishing a sick bank for Timothy J. O'Brien.

*Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the executive office of health and human services, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule, or regulation to the contrary, the executive
- 2 office of health and human services shall establish a sick leave bank for Timothy J. O'Brien, an
- 3 employee of the office. Any employee of the office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,
- 4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Timothy J. O'Brien. Whenever
- 5 Timothy J. O'Brien terminates employment with the office or requests to dissolve the sick leave
- 6 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave

7 bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability  
8 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the office of health  
9 and human services.
