AN ACT RELATIVE TO SCHOOL INTERNET SAFETY POLICIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following new section: -
- 3 Section 90. Every city, town, regional school district or vocational school which provides
- 4 computer access to minors shall have a policy regarding internet safety measures and shall make
- 5 this policy known to the parents and guardians of minors. Determination of these individual
- 6 policies as well as standards and rules for the enforcement of this provision shall be prescribed
- 7 by the school committee in conjunction with the superintendent.
