An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Margaret A. Bagley, an employee of the Trial Court.. *Whereas,* the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to [Emergency Preamble Text] convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the trial court shall
- 2 establish a sick leave bank for Margaret A. Bagley, an employee of the department of the trial
- 3 court. Any employee of the trial court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or
- 4 vacation days to the sick leave bank for the use by Margaret A. Bagley. Sick leave bank days
- 5 shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the
- 6 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the trial court. Whenever Margaret A.
- 7 Bagley terminates employment with the trial court or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank,
- 8 any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the trial court paid leave bank.
