Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 Definitions:

4 Community Based Organization-means a public or private nonprofit organization of

- 5 demonstrated effectiveness that—
- 6 (A) is representative of a community or significant segments of a community; and
- 7 (B) provides educational or related services to individuals in the community
- 8 Non-service hours-hours that are defined and posted by the community based
- 9 organizations when the public facilities are not in use by their programs or any subsidiaries of
- 10 said Community Based Organization

Except as provided in this section, a school district [and school personnel] [is/are] not liable for any loss or injury arising from the use of indoor or outdoor school property and facilities made available for public recreation or sport during non-school hours. Nothing in this section limits the liability of a school district [and school personnel] for willful or malicious failure to guard or warn against a dangerous condition, use, structure or activity; or acts or omissions constituting gross, willful or wanton negligence.

Except as provided in this section, a community based organization as defined by as defined above [and community organization personnel] [is/are] not liable for any loss or injury arising from the use of outdoor property and facilities made available for public recreation or sport during non-service hours
